The Starfish class was busy during the month of April even though it was an abbreviated month due to Spring Break.



We started the month learning about bugs and where they live and how useful they are to our environment. We learned that insects have six legs and made paper plate bugs to present in the Art Show next month. We made grasshoppers, butterflies, and we even had students make cockroaches and stick bugs.

The second week of the month was all about Easter. We went on a scavenger hunt using clues that the Easter Bunny left and found an Easter basket with a golden egg with chocolates to share with the class. We had amazing parents send in Easter Eggs for our Easter Egg Hunt. There were many to be found!

After Spring Break, we returned to learn about how plants grow from seeds. The students now know seeds need soil and water to sprout, and wind and sun to grow into flowers, and that bees are very important to get fruits and vegetables. The students also learned about the parts of a plant. They went outside to blow dandelions that had gone to

seed, so they could help spread the seeds for new flowers to grow and bloom. Our door was decorated beautifully with flowers that we made with watercolors and coffee filters.

We were able to introduce the letters X, Y, and Z, numbers 26, 27, and 28, and introduced the oval shape. We cannot believe the school year has flown so quickly, but we look forward to what our last month of the school year will bring to the Starfish class.
