Starfish students were very busy during the month of May. We started our month continuing to learn about different types of insects and bugs. We learned that insects have six legs...unlike the spider who has eight, and that caterpillars turn into butterflies and moths.

The second week of May was all about Moms! The children made a beautiful present for their mothers by creating butterflies, hearts, and flowers using their handprints. The artwork was framed with thumbprint flowers, and "signatures" of the students on the back of the frame.

The last few weeks of the month we learned about ocean animals. We spent a lot of our learning talking about animals that we could find in the Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic Ocean, and we came to agreement that we don't want to encounter a jellyfish or shark this summer, but we are okay with starfish and dolphins. We also learned about Summer Safety. We talked about: always swim with a buddy, wear sunscreen to protect our skin from burns, drink plenty of water to stay hydrated, and many more summer safety practices.

Our Annual Art Show was amazing! Starfish students created art inspired by Monet, arctic animals, penguins, dinosaurs, bugs, and rainbows. Beautiful art was displayed throughout the halls of ASDS and many Starfish students were very proud of what they created and showed their work off to their parents and friends.

feeling the beat. Another focus starting in January has been pitch. The students progressed from identifying high and low sounds to beginning to understand pitch relationships using solfège (Do, Re, Mi, Fa, Sol, La, Ti) syllables.

But the most important goal this year was having fun and being silly with music. And through this fun and silliness, developing confidence. I was never short of volunteers during our Performance Today time. Students would stand up in front of their classmates to sing and perform. What a joy for me!



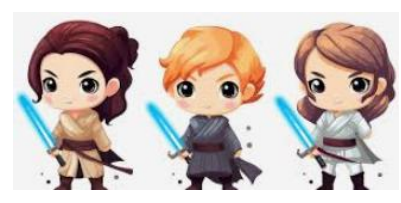
