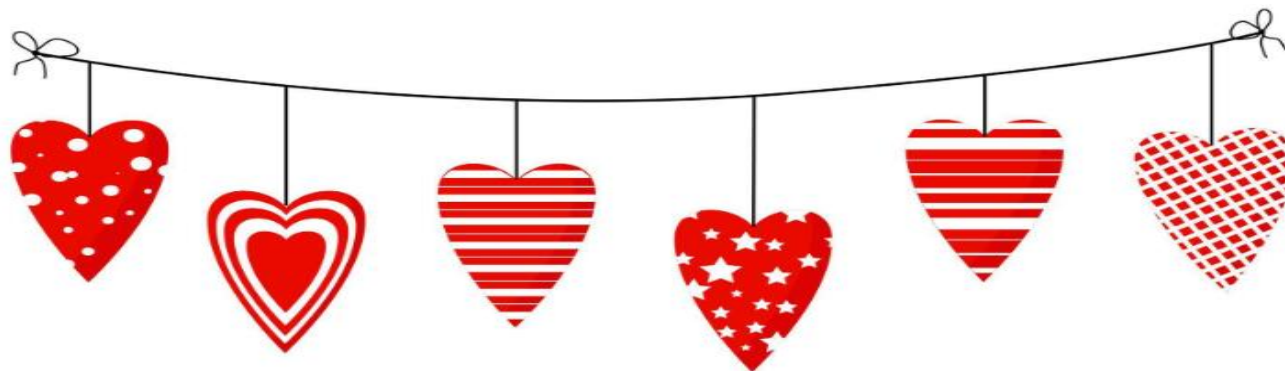
January Birthdays

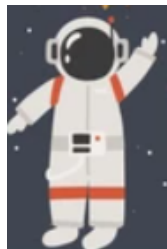

Starfish students were ready to get back to school and start a new year during the month of January. The first week of January we learned about the season of winter. The students noticed the temperature outside getting colder and they had to wear coats, hats, and mittens to the playground to keep warm. They also saw that the leaves on the trees were gone and the limbs were bare. We discussed the days getting shorter and the nights were longer during winter. We introduced the letter W this week.

The second week of January we learned about snow and ice. We read, *Sneezy the Snowman*, and made melted snowmen.

Arctic Animals took over the third week of the month. We learned about caribou, harp seals, snowy owls, polar bears, walruses, narwhals, arctic foxes, beluga whales, and snowshoe hares. The children chose and created arctic animals for our art show. They made polar bears out of paper plates and we watched videos of arctic animals in their natural environment.

The last week of January was all about penguins. The children learned that there are many different types of penguins and they live in several places on Earth. They were introduced to the Little Blue Penguin, Chinstrap Penguin, Emperor Penguin, King Penguin, Galapagos Penguin, and Macaroni Penguin. We learned how they can swim to catch fish and how they live in large groups called colonies. We danced to *The Penguin Dance*, and the students created their penguin families with a process art project.

We were able to introduce the letters W, I, N, and D, numbers 14, 15, 16, and 17 and the rectangle shape. The Starfish students continue to amaze us each day with how much they are learning, and we can't wait to see what February brings to our class.

The Sea Turtles made paper dolls and dressed them in winter clothing. The winter theme continued by learning about snow, snowmen, and penguins. We created snowmen from circles, roller pin penguins and painted ice. We are hoping that February is warmer so we can continue to spend time with the older kids on the playground.

Music classes started off the new year with many new songs, and we have begun to dive into musical concepts, starting with pitch and rhythm. A class favorite is a song about a horse named Old Joe. Old Joe can trot, walk, jump, and run. Through this movement, students practice moving to the beat with different rhythms. Students have also explored beat and rhythm by adding many instruments to our songs including drums, egg shakers, tambourines, sand blocks, and rhythm sticks.

Be sure to ask your child to show you the "sol, mi, do" hand gestures. Students have been using Kodály hand gestures in class when singing. This fun activity helps create a foundation of understanding pitch relationships.

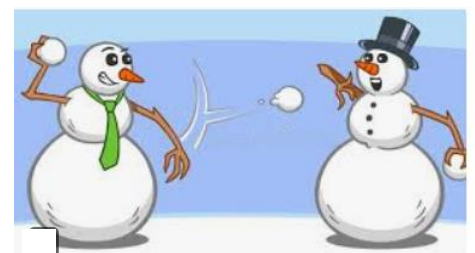
Happy New Year!!!!
