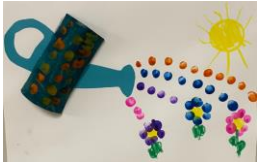

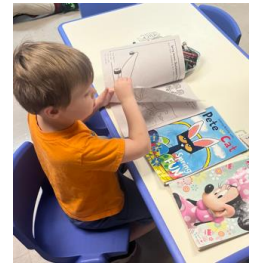


## From the Classrooms

When we returned from Spring Break, we enjoyed a Spring Review of all we have learned so far and worked on some art projects. We ended the month by celebrating Earth Day. We talked about the importance of taking care of our planet by reducing, reusing and recycling. We learned about the letters “L,” “I,” “R” and “K.” We are looking forward to May, but we can’t believe the year is almost over!

What a fun April The Stingrays have had! We started April with our Easter Egg Hunt. Such fun! We’ve also been working so hard on our beautiful artwork for our Annual Art Show. We have finished learning all the letters of the alphabet, recognizing the sounds for the letter Ee. Our sight word was **each**. Now we are reviewing a letter each day to see what we’ve retained. We have also categorized our vowels and consonants displayed in the classroom. The Stingrays continue working on writing their names and lowercase/capital letters. Both are so much fun! We are also learning to spell our last names orally.

In math, we are counting by 1’s, 5’s, and 10’s, and working with greater than/ less than signs, and computing simple addition sums. The are really doing well calculating the answers in their heads. Of course, we are practicing writing our numerals, too.

During Earth Day Week we discussed how to protect this big, beautiful planet of ours! We now know about how we can help by recycling, throwing trash away in the proper place, using less water, conserving energy and not polluting our ocean, bays and canals.

## Mr. Trosclair of the Music Studio



This month, we have been revisiting some of the children's favorite songs and activities they learned throughout the school year. We went on our "Bear Hunt" again, exploring beat and rhythm. I was excited to see the growth among the students. They are feeling the beat, marching with the beat, and moving to the different rhythms more effectively. The Sea Turtles' new favorite is "Row, Row, Row Your Boat." The students make some fun changes to the song as we row down the

stream. The Sea Turtles are becoming more confident in their singing, singing loud for all to hear. The Starfish have been playing instruments to the beat of "A Sailor Went to Sea, Sea, Sea" and "Wishy Washy." The most challenging part is holding the instrument perfectly still until the correct part in the song. The Starfish have shown growth in fine motor control on these instruments. The Stingrays and Sea Otters are drumming to music notation I write on the board. The students do some basic reading of the music notation then drum the rhythm on the floor using rhythm sticks. Be sure to ask to sing and play "Head and Shoulders" with your child. They love it!

Happy May!

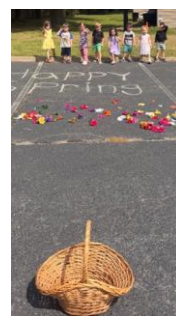
What a busy month! We've had some great weather and lots of outdoor time.
