From the Classrooms






In February, the students started each music class with beat and rhythm. During our bear hunt, students marched to the beat as we traveled to find the bear. Students also moved their feet to different rhythms as we made our way through many obstacles like grass, mud, and a snowstorm.



After the bear hunt, we slowed down a bit to focus on pitch. The Starfish, Stingrays, and Sea Otters are making their way through the major scale. Think "sol la sol," "sol-mi-do," and "sol-fa-mi-re-do."

The Sea Turtles and Starfish have been working on fine motor control with percussion instruments. In "A Sailor Went To Sea, Sea, Sea," the students need to wait (very hard to do), holding an egg shaker, sand block, or tambourine until the right moment in the song. They also worked on holding and playing each instrument with more control.

In another song, "Johnny Works with One Hammer," the Sea Turtles and Starfish worked with rhythmic sticks and mallets on the carpet. Students played on the beat with right hand or left hand alone, both hands together, and alternating between hands.



The Stingrays and Sea Otters have been learning drumming and tambourine techniques with the song, "Get Up!" The students have also been singing, "Good Morning, Blues" with band accompaniment through the speaker. Individual students have been singing alone in front of the class with the accompaniment. I am never short for volunteers. I am proud to see all the hands in the air when I ask for a one.

Music is not complete with fun and games! Some favorites have been "All Who Were Born In January, Skip Around" and "Wake Me, Shake Me." Be sure to request a favorite song from your child on the car ride home!
