We started to verbally spell our last names and are practicing writing our first names.

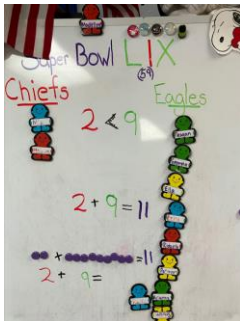
We celebrated Groundhog's Day by voting to see if Punxsutawney Phil saw his shadow or not.
